*Camping is available onsite next to the park for a \$25 camping fee. Electricity is available but water is limited and there is no dump station. A very limited number of vehicles and/or motor homes will be permitted to park with their booths and must have prior authorization. Availability will be at the sole discretion of the festival organizers, and the \$25 camping fee will still apply.

NOTICE: The selling of weapons or knives (including toy, specialty and collectible), projectiles, explosives, numb chucks, cigarette papers, pipes not for traditional tobacco consumption, drug-related paraphernalia (including clothing items that promote illicit drug usage), and other offensive or unsuitable items (including, but not limited to, silly string or anything in pressurized cans) is prohibited. Live animal displays are also prohibited (Vendor's pets are allowed but must be kept away from the crowd). IN THE EVENT A FESTIVAL REPRESENTATIVE DEEMS AN ITEM NOT SUITABLE FOR DISPLAY OR SALE, PERSONS OPERATING THE BOOTH WILL BE ASKED TO STOP SALES AND/OR LEAVE THE PREMISES. IN SUCH AN EVENT, ALL FEES WILL BE FORFEITED. WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO DENY PARTICIPATION IN THE GLASS FESTIVAL.

The Glass Festival carries a non redundancy policy in an effort to make the festival profitable for all vendors. Many vendors offer the same or similar products. All efforts will be made to protect vendors from

over saturation of product availability. If you specialize in a particular product or product line the festival will not accept another specialty vendor of the same product. However, many vendors offer multiple products and redundancy cannot be entirely eliminated. This policy is enforced as fairly as possible and offered on a first come first served basis.

PLEASE LIST ALL ITEMS YOU WILL BE SELLING _____

Set-up time will be on Thursday, 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. No vehicles will be allowed inside the park after 8 p.m. on Thursday. Exclusions include medical reasons or vehicles that are an integral part of the vendor's business, either of which will require permission from the festival director prior to July 1st. ALL BOOTHS MUST REMAIN OPEN DURING THE SCHEDULED HOURS. *If you do not intend to be open during the schedule hours, do not return the application.*

It is the duty and responsibility of the vendor to be compliant with Department of Homeland Security. To find information on state requirements contact the Indiana Department of Building and Fire Code Enforcement.

All attempts will be made to provide returning vendors with the same location as the year before, or accommodate requests for new locations if this application is returned by July 1. However, acceptance of this contract does not guarantee a particular location.

FEES: ALL FEES MUST BE PAID AT TIME OF APPLICATION. Refund request made prior to July 1st are available.
