- Parade check in begins at 8:00 a.m. at Main Street Auto and Tire, 1410 Main Street.
- All parade units must check in prior to the parade and should be assembled by 9:15 a.m. A pre-judging will take place at this time. Ribbons will be given to the winners before the parade starts and will be announced at Callaway Park at 1 p.m. at the St. Vincent Mercy Hospital Main Stage.
- The parade will line up and travel North Anderson Street (starting at South A Street) turning east on North J Street and then north on 19th Street traveling past the Glass Festival and ending at the high school parking lot.
- Parade entries must be received at the Elwood Chamber of Commerce by Friday, August 13, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. All entries received after this deadline will be placed at the end of the parade.
- Parade handouts are encouraged and accepted. The parade spectators love free promotional items, candy. Necklaces, beach balls, etc.; however, we will not tolerate anything being thrown from vehicles.
- No squirt guns are allowed.
- All horse categories will be placed at the back of the parade route. The exception to this rule will be that the horses have on diapers. (Please specify on parade application)
